14.1 Conference Champion

14.1.1 The conference champion shall be decided by the winner of the post-season conference tournament. The top four teams will advance to the conference tournament to be played the weekend before the NCAA Tournament. On Friday, No. 4 will play at No. 1 and No. 3 will play at No. 2. The winners will advance to the championship to be played at the higher seed on Sunday.

14.1.2 The tie-breakers in determining seeding and finish in standings shall be as follows:

2 teams

1. head-to-head result

3 teams (If at any point one team is eliminated in this process, the process immediately goes back to #1)

1. Head-to-head-to-head results
2. Least goals against amongst three teams in designated conference games.
3. Goals against versus all conference opponents
4. Goals for versus other two teams involved in tie
5. Goals for versus all other conference opponents
