17.1 Conference Champion

17.1.1 A four-team single elimination tournament will decide conference champion. The championship will be played on a Saturday/Sunday at the highest seed. In the event of a tie after overtime in the championship game, co-champions will be declared and penalty kicks will determine the conference automatic qualifier. The participants in the tournament will be determined by a point system (three points for a win, one point for a tie) in round-robin conference play. The school with the highest point total will have the right to host regardless of the type of playing surface.

17.1.2 In the event of a tie, the tie-breakers shall be as follows:

- 1.** Points earned among head-to-head competition between tied teams.
- 2.** Most wins within the conference
- 3.** Least total goals allowed by each of the tied teams in games against each other.
- 4.** Most total goals scored by each of the tied teams in games against each other (to a maximum of 3 per game).
- 5.** Points earned against the highest remaining conference teams in descending order.
- 6.** Goal differential in all conference games (max +/- 3 per game).
- 7.** Least total goals allowed in all conference games (max +/- 3 per game).
- 8.** Most total goals scored in all conference games (up to a maximum of 3 per game).
- 9.** Points earned against all common opponents.
- 10.** Coin toss by conference official.
